PEACE RIVER JEEPERS BYLAWS



CLUB PURPOSES

Peace River Jeepers is a non-profit Club whose purposes are:

1. To promote and foster a spirit of friendliness and cooperation among its members
2. To assist in maintaining, customizing, and promoting "Jeeping"
3. To follow the "Tread Lightly" guidelines, and
4. To be an asset to the community

MEMBERSHIP

Membership is open to all persons 18 years of age or older, who own a Jeep of any model and vintage. Dues are \$40.00 annually, and they are due and payable on the member's anniversary date of each year in order to remain current. All current members have the right to vote or hold office.

OFFICERS and DUTIES

The Officers of the Club shall be:

President
Vice-President
Secretary
Treasurer
Webmaster

President: Shall preside in the capacity of President at all meetings. Shall appoint committees and be a member of all committees. The President shall vote only in the case of a tie vote.

Vice-President: Shall preside in the capacity of the President in the absence of the President. Shall act as advisor and work closely with the President to assist in all matters.

Secretary: Shall record the Minutes of all meetings. Shall receive and reply to all Club correspondence (other than email.) Shall maintain membership records.

Treasurer: Shall keep and maintain records of the Club's financial activities and provide those records to the officers for monthly review.

Webmaster: Shall maintain, update, and keep the web site current. Shall correspond, via e-mail, with other clubs and moderate the Club's Private Online Forum.

[NOTE: All Officers shall be elected for a period of two years at the first meeting after the start of the calendar year. Any four Officers shall constitute a quorum at all meetings.]

MEETINGS

General membership meetings are usually held on the second Thursday of each month at a place suggested by the Officers and agreed upon by the membership. Any changes will be posted on the Peace River Jeepers' web site, www.peaceriverjeepers.com.

The Officers' meetings are to be held prior to the general meetings and are to be called by the President as to time and location.

CONDUCT OF MEMBERS

All Club members shall respect one another, each others' vehicles and personal property. Anyone not adhering to these principles, or who endangers others, shall be dealt with by the Officers on an individual basis. Depending upon the incident, reprimand could be severe enough to include a majority membership vote for expulsion from the Club.

GENERAL

The Club reserves the right to amend its Bylaws at anytime. Any proposed Amendment shall be submitted in writing to the Officers, read and discussed at the next regularly scheduled meeting, and held over for one month, at which time a vote of the membership will be taken for its ratification. A majority vote of those present will be required to pass the proposed Amendment.

All assets are to be dedicated to the Club and utilized as the majority of the membership so decides.

All vehicles participating in trail events must be properly registered and insured, with the exception of those trailered Jeeps which are customized strictly for off-road purposes and which are not street legal. The Club is not liable for damages incurred to vehicles on a trail ride or at any other Club event. All members and guests participate at their own risk.

WHO WE ARE:

We are a Jeep club, open to all owners of Jeeps and their families. We are a not for profit organization. Our purpose is to share in educational and recreational activities with other jeepers. We adhere to all local laws and to the Tread Lightly Program.

MEETINGS:

Meetings are held 7 pm on the 2nd Thursday of each month at Beef O' Brady's in Port Charlotte (or other location to be posted on website).

Trail rides are held on a month by month basis. Information to be posted on website and/or discussed at meetings. Please be gassed up and ready to go before you arrive.

MEMBERSHIP:

Basically membership is open to anyone owning a Jeep, of any vintage or model.

EVENTS:

Events consist of trail rides, wrenching parties and socials. We will join other clubs in their events and share our events as the case may be.

We are a family oriented club and our events are planned accordingly.

Going off road could cause concern to those who have not done so, but there is always someone to help the beginner become proficient.

MORE ABOUT TRAIL RIDES:

Trail rides may be attended by any member, guest or potential member. We ask that all participants follow our TRAIL RULES so as to make each ride an enjoyable experience for all.

Plans for rides are brought up at our meetings and plans are then made. Rides are designed for the hobbyists and are not designed for the extreme.

New members are given Trail Rules and required equipment lists and are asked to please conform before the third ride. This makes it better for everyone.

TRAIL RIDE RULES:

NO alcoholic or illegal substances allowed.

Follow the "Trail Boss"

Stay in line and always keep the Jeep in front and the Jeep behind in sight.

Seat belts or proper restraints for all occupants while Jeep is in motion.

Lights on when traveling on public roads.

Dispose of nothing, proper refuse mandatory.

Always carry a trash bag and try to pick up anything that needs to be cleaned up.

Do nothing to endanger the environment or others.

Should your Jeep become stuck or immovable, stay with your Jeep and assist anyone rendering assistance. (Thank You works really well)

If "MUDDING" please do so in a safe place so as not to interfere with those who chose to stay clear.

EQUIPMENT:

Tow points front and rear

Looped tow strap, no chains or hooks

CB radio (channel 2 on trails)

Fire extinguisher

First aid kit and if needed medical alert

Full tank of gas

Trash bags.

Remember: You are ultimately responsible for you, your passengers and your vehicle. Peace River Jeepers will not assume any responsibility during Trail rides or events.
